Installation and sound check

Please allow a minimum of 30 minutes for set-up and 1 hour for sound check.

Personnel required: a sound technician (reception) and a lighting technician. We would bring our own sound engineer, if possible.

Sound gear to be supplied by the promoter/organizer :

- -1x coherent, professional-quality sound system adapted to the venue **WITH SUBS**
- This system must be installed and tested prior to the team's arrival, and must provide sufficient sound pressure (at least 100dB) evenly throughout the venue.
- -1x professional console with minimum 32 inputs
- -6x monitor circuits and minimum 6 identical monitors
- -1x 2x31-band graphic EQ as front panel insert (if the console doesn't have one)
- -1x 31-band graphic EQ on each monitor circuit (if the console doesn't have one)
- -List of microphones and DIs mentioned in the sound patch, or equivalent models

DIGITAL CONSOLE PREFERRED.

- In the case of an analog console, it must be of professional quality and feature full parametric EQ, at least 6 pre-fader Auxes and 4 post-fader Auxes, as well as :
- 4 M-One or SPX 990 effects processors
- 8 compressors and 4 gates
- 1x 2x31-band graphic EQ as front-panel insert
- 1x 31-band graphic EQ on each monitor circuit

Bass

(1) Bass amp – at least 300 Watts. 2x10 inch (2x25.4cm) cabinets or 4x10 inch (4x25.4cm) cabinets preferred. Preferred brands : Mark Bass CMD 151p, Ampeg, Héritage b-15, Eden Wt800 + D410, Aguilar, (1-2) monitor.

Drum

(1) Complete drum set. Preferred brands Gretsch, Yamaha. 1 Bass drum 20” (with drum pedal), 1 floor tom 14”, 1 medium tom 12”, 1 snare drum. 3 cymbals stands, 1 hi hat stand, 1 drum seat, 1 drum carpet. (1-2) monitor.


Keyboards
